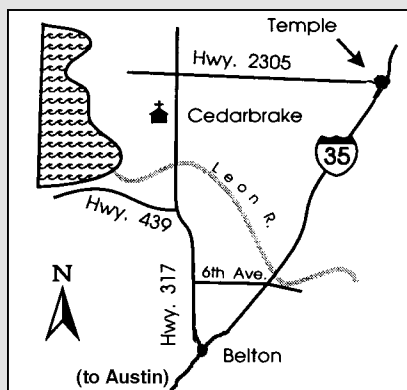
**Where:** Cedarbrake Catholic Retreat Center, Belton, Texas

**Directions to Cedarbrake**

Traveling north or south on IH35, take the 6th Avenue exit (294B) in Belton. Continue west on 6th Ave. until it dead-ends into Main Street (traffic light). Turn right on North Main (N. Main becomes Hwy 317), and continue north for 3.4 miles. The CEDARBRAKE entrance drive is on the west (left) side of the highway, and is marked by a large pylon sign. There is a sign on the fence that reads DIOCESE OF AUSTIN. Enter the Cedarbrake grounds and drive to the Perry House for check-in

# The Weekend at a Glance:

## **SESSIONS**

- **Discernment:** the prayerful process by which one discovers God's will. The process enables one to distinguish between movements coming from God and impulses that are not from God.
- **Prayer:** how to pray about your calling in life
- **Types of Vocations and their relationships:** Through the sacrament of Baptism, each person receives 'a call' or vocation. All are called to holiness and to serve. This call can be lived out in a variety of ways - as a married or single person, or as a priest, brother or sister, each in relationship with the other.
- **Practical steps to take to help you discern your vocation**
- **Men's and Women's Discussion Groups**

- **Emmaus Walk:** discussion time alone with a diocesan or religious priests, brothers or sisters of your choice. These one-on-one sessions take place while walking on the beautiful grounds or sitting quietly in a corner of the retreat center.
